Will you hold my hand? Have you ever been asked this question? I'm sure all of us at one point or another have held hands with someone. Growing up we sang a song called Precious Lord hold my hand, and as the older saints would sing, you could tell that they knew what it meant to walk hand in hand with Christ. My prayer for my life and the lives of my family, immediate and church, is that we would allow God to take our hand as we take his, so that when life gets rough and we want to let go he will keep ahold and help guide us through.
