Dear Church Family,

As I write these words it is one week before Christmas and only two before the commencement of a new year. Right now, it is not so much "sugarplums dancing in my head" as it is the thoughts of a new calendar and all that comes with it.

- 4. How can I help a brother or sister in Christ in their journey with Christ?
- 5. What can I do to strengthen the life and witness of our congregation?

Asking these questions is only the beginning. From there we are called to pray and ask for the Lord's guidance in making course adjustments in the journey so that we can grow closer to Him.

In 2020, it is my desire that we will truly have 20/20 vision by asking tough questions in our spiritual walk as we seek to be more like Him daily. I believe that God is calling us to lives of 20/20 vision and that we as a Church must place focus on discipleship.

As Christians we get very excited about new people coming to the Lord—and we should! But accepting Christ is not the end of the journey, we are ALL called to grow in the Lord. I want us to get equally excited about helping one another to truly become disciples of Christ. How can we help others—and ourselves—to grow in the Lord's grace?

In 2020, I will be talking about and asking about what we as a congregation can do to strengthen our discipleship in the Lord. Let's begin this path by asking the foundational questions that I have just shared so that we all might truly have **20/20 VISION in 2020**.
