Dear Church Family,

What is revival? It is a word we throw around all the time, but what does it mean?

I hear many times people praying for revival to come to our land, that large numbers of lost people will come to the Lord. Hopefully the lost will turn their eyes upon Jesus. When that happens, it is not a revival but a spiritual awakening (the dead can't be revived).

In Baptist life it frequently means a week or so of services where again the lost will be persuaded to accept Christ's gift of salvation. Revival comes from God so we cannot schedule that. But we can schedule a time of focusing our hearts and minds on the Lord and praying that revival will come to our church, and all of our churches.

While I pray for all of these movements of the spirit to take place, those don't really define revival. Revival is about the Church.

As we who are saved have been sidetracked by Satan and have taken our eyes off God, we need to come back to our first love, Jesus Christ (Revelation 2:4). Revival comes when our Lord calls us back to Him and we respond to His call. When the Church returns to the Lord, He does mighty things through us!

The best definition of revival that I have ever found comes from Zechariah 1:3: "Therefore tell the people: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Return to me,' declares the LORD Almighty, 'and I will return to you,' says the LORD Almighty."

Every year the Coffee Creek Baptist Association schedules a week of Revival services, which are coming up on 13-17 September.
