As important as our personal dates are to all, there are others that are milestones in human history. What days come to your mind that have "rocked our world" and have made a major impact upon all our lives?

A date I heard frequently growing up was December 7. I can remember my father sharing about the impact of Pearl Harbor on his life and those that he knew, especially his schoolteacher who had a son and daughter who were killed during the attack.

One of the things that amazed me was that he could tell me exactly where he was when he learned of it. As a child I was astounded that one could remember where they were when they heard such world news. Silently I kind of wondered if my dad really could remember or if it was just his imagination. Then came 9/11...I don't wonder anymore!

If I was to ask you what the most important date was in world history, what would you choose? Knowing the impact that December 7 and September 11 have made on our national saga perhaps you would choose one of these.

As noteworthy as these dates are, let me share one that is far more important and that has truly "rocked our world." Oddly enough it is a date that we don't know with absolute certainty, but the events of that early morning have truly changed all our lives in great and marvelous ways.

What is this magnanimous day? It is one that we read about in Luke 24:1-7:

On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: "The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.""

This is the event that has brought the greatest joy to human life! This is the occurrence that we gather to celebrate every Lord's Day! This is the episode that we base our calendars on! This is the incident that has truly changed all world history! This is none other than a dead man getting up and walking again! This is the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ!

I am so looking forward to celebrating with you all as we gather on Sunday, April 17, to proclaim that "He Is Risen! He Is Risen Indeed!"

Come join us at 7:30 a.m. for the SONrise Service and Breakfast, and at 10:30 a.m. for Worship on Easter Sunday as we realize that Jesus Christ died for our sins, we rejoice that He truly lives today!
