

Dear Church Family,

Many folks skip over Romans 16, because it is just a bunch of names—and half of them are hard to pronounce! Let me encourage you not to fly by this chapter, we might learn something as we are introduced to all the people that Paul listed.

Paul greets fellow workers, sisters, relatives, and several by character. What is interesting to me is that three are noted as being friends: Epenetus (16:5), Stachys (16:9), Persis (16:12). Paul does not use this word very often (only twice more in Colossians and Philemon), and that got me thinking about what it means to be a friend.

When I think of a friend, I think of one who is there for me. Like the Apostle says in Romans 12:15, "Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn." A friend is available no matter what the need may be.

When we go back to the Old Testament, we learn of the three friends of Job—Eliphaz, Bildad, Zophar—who were there in his time of need (Job 2:11). But they do something unique for Job (2:13), they sit in silence with him for seven days! He was suffering and they did not say a word for seven days!

Now, before I go any further, I must note that beginning with the fourth chapter that all changed. The majority of this forty-two-chapter book is a dialog (a fuss?), between Job and his friends. But let's ignore that for a minute...

For seven days, Job's friends were there for him. They did not try to help him work through his problems, his grief, his frustrations. Instead, they were just present with him.

Let me be honest, this is a hard concept for me. My calling is one all about words. Proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ, answering questions and explaining Biblical truths, communicating with people, and consoling in their time of need. I always feel a need to say something!

But I learned a long time ago that many individuals don't need our opinions as much as they need our presence. I've learned it firsthand when I received unsolicited guidance that sounded more like criticism, and when I had an arm around my shoulder with no words (also, trust me, many occasions of sage wisdom that was God appointed!).

I don't know what Paul thought of when he identified a brother or sister in Christ as a friend, but I do know what comes to my heart. Those many who have faithfully been there for me. Sharing words when needed, but most importantly those who were just there for me even in their silence. Displaying true love for me.

Sisters and Brothers, who do we know that needs a real friend? Who needs us to rejoice with them, and mourn with them? Who needs to experience true love?

Is God sending them your way for a reason?
