Dear Church Family,

Perhaps you know the quote, “Music that soothes the savage beast.” I have heard it for most of my life, but I did not know where it originated. The British playwright, William Congreve (1670-1729), opened one of his plays with the words, “Music hath charms to soothe the savage breast. To soften rocks or bend the knotted oak.”

Our society lives by this adage to make it through the day, we live in a world permeated by song. Everywhere we turn there are tunes playing in the background. We take it for granted that television and movies will have soundtracks. Many of us rely on our car radios or even cell phones to calm us down with music that speaks to our souls.

While Congreve coined the phrase, this truth has been known to believers through God’s Holy Word. It was the Apostle Paul who admonished us to sing “psalms and hymns and spiritual songs,” as a means of daily walking with our Lord Jesus Christ.

I know that I live by this...whether I am going down the road or in the middle of work, I am always breaking out in song or at least the words and melody of songs will flow through my mind.

When I am sad, I sing “Joy to the World.”

When I am frustrated, I sing “My Lord Is Near Me All the Time.”

When I am excited, I “Shout to the Lord.”

When I am discouraged, I sing “Have Faith in God.”

When I need to remember that God is in control, I sing about His “Amazing Grace.”

I always encourage folks to meditate on God’s Word throughout the week, and I do not want to take away from that. But let me also suggest that you take a song that we have sung in worship and sing it and ponder on its meaning throughout your week.

The world bombards us with music that is primarily self-centered and hedonistic in its content. Let’s bathe our lives with songs that point to our Lord Jesus Christ, the One who brings meaning and thankfulness to our hearts.

Focusing on “Jesus lyrics” will soothe our hearts, minds, and souls and make us more loving in our savage world. May the word of Christ—not the world—dwell in us richly!
