Dear Church Family,

I love to sing the old Christmas carols or hymns! They are full of familiar words because I've sung them all my life. I guess the recognizable serves as a sense of comfort in our crazy old world. And, you know our crazy old world never listens to "Jesus songs," but they sure love to sing the words of those old and cherished tunes just as much as we do.

One of the things that draws me to these carols is without question their theological depth. I find it fascinating to listen to the world sing words with gusto that they don't really understand or believe. Let me give you an example...

A favorite of mine is "Hark! The Herald Angels Sing." The recurring "Glory to the newborn king" are words of praise lifted to our Lord Jesus Christ, praise that He richly deserves!

But the depth increases by sharing the joy of the Incarnation (NOTE: What is incarnation? It is from the Latin that means "flesh," and it speaks to God taking on a human form and coming to earth). The third verse notes that "Mild He lays His glory by," which speaks to how God set aside the glory of Heaven to meet us in our world. The second verse is even bolder in proclaiming, "Veiled in flesh the Godhead see," or that God took on flesh and blood in our lives, and praises the Lord saying, "Hail th' incarnate Deity," God stepped out of the glory of Heaven to walk in our world.

During the Sundays of Advent I want us to examine this doctrine of the Incarnation in depth, by simply asking the question, "Why Did Jesus Come to Earth?" While many will only want to focus on the joy of the season (and we should celebrate by all means!), this is also a time for us to pause and go deeper in our faith and understanding of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Here is a list of scriptures that we will be examining each Sunday of Advent. Let me encourage you to read over them in preparation of worship during this season. Yes, even amongst the lights and revelry, by all means let's grow in the "grace and knowledge of our Lord" daily. Remember, Jesus is the reason for the season!
