Dear Church Family,

For several years now our church has been faithful in sending out parcels of joy through Operation Christmas Child. It is always a moving occasion to see our children and youth parade into the sanctuary with the multitude of boxes for us to pray over before sending them around the world. Thank you for your generosity in providing and supporting this mission of blessings!

NOTE: The Parade of Blessing the Boxes will take place on Sunday, 12 November, at the beginning of morning worship. I am looking forward to this exciting moment in the life of our church!

This year we have an amazing opportunity to expand on our OCC Ministry that I encourage us all to support with our time and labors. Once a church collects all those boxes, they are then taken to a location known as a Drop Off Center (DOC). Our county has been without a DOC location for the last year or two and we—Kimberlin Creek Baptist Church—have been asked to serve in this vital capacity.

Each night (and some days) we will need a team of folks to gather in our Family Life Center to accept all those boxes that will come in from around Scott County. There is some detail work that will go on—such as counting, recording, and crating boxes—but it will mainly be a time to greet, help, and enjoy all the folks who come to bring their gifts to the children of the world.

I like the philosophy of Samaritan's Purse, that a DOC is to be "transformational and not transactional." What does this mean? Transactional is to accept boxes and go to the next person or function, all business. Transformational means that we meet people, celebrate with them, accept their gifts with thankfulness, and even pray with them. We will be having folks come out to our church building throughout the week who might be tired, worn down, and exhausted, and we can offer them a smile and a caring heart. That's showing love in Christ's name!

We will be needing four or five willing souls to work each shift, over eight days. This is an outreach and ministry that everyone can do, men and women, boys and girls. We are all needed!

Come and be a part of the joy of sharing the love of Jesus Christ around the world and even to our community during National Drop Off Week!
