Bethel Baptist of Leota was privileged to be one of 31 congregations selected to participate in the Center for Congregations' Mental Health Initiative. During 2024, our planning team has had the opportunity to experience four different training experiences. We've learned more about what comprises good mental health. How mental health problems can affect our physical health and even our spiritual health.

We spent a good portion of the summer interviewing various people in our community and in our own church to learn what they think are the most critical mental health needs. The next step for our planning team is to take what we learned from the interviews and draft a plan of how we can address mental health problems in a way that can be sustainable even after the funding is gone.

We will submit a "draft" proposal to the Center for Congregations in mid-September with the final draft due mid-October. Our project officer, Shellie Jordan, will help us fine-tune our proposal. Then at the close of the year, we will receive \$40,000 that will be used for our project in 2025. We are excited to see how God can work through our project and be able to touch on mental health needs in our church and in our community.

Other Happenings at Bethel: our annual drive-through Nativity, "Journey to Bethlehem" is scheduled for Saturday, December 7 from 6:00-8:00pm. Walk-through is from 8:00-8:30. We have a scheduled a "rain date" for Saturday, December 14th. So, in case of rain or stormy weather, the event will be on the 14th instead of the 7th.

Once again, we will collect canned goods, or non-perishable food items for the Clearinghouse. All cash donations will be given to the Edna Martin Christian Center food drive in February.

Sunday, December 15th at 6:00 we will have our Bethlehem Concert. Last year's performers were Brian Allen, Josh Richards (from Flamekeeper), Kayla & Steve Griffen, and on the House.
