Dear Church Family,

Welcome to our inaugural newsletter of 2025! As we look forward to the coming twelve months, I can't help but wonder what all the Father has in store for us. It is appropriate as we enter a new year to review our previous walk with the Lord and make plans for our continuing journey with Him.

Many folks develop "New Year's Resolutions" on or around January 1. They usually have to do with areas of our lives like finances, health, etc. I know from my contacts at the YMCA that this is the popular time of the year for new gym memberships, and many go by the wayside in a few months.

Resolutions often carry a questionable character due to how quickly they can be forgotten. But I don't just want to brush them away. I believe that in our walk with the Lord we need to frequently take an assessment and seek to find ways to go deeper.

In my readings, I came across a quote from Jonathan Edwards (1703-1758) that spoke to me on this thought: "Resolution One: I will live for God. Resolution Two: If no one else does, I still will." As Rev. Edwards notes, our spiritual commitment needs dogged determination. I encourage all of us to resolve, or better yet, rededicate our lives to our Lord Jesus Christ in this new year.

Let me share an opportunity for all of us to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (II Peter 3:18). For the last couple of months we have talked about beginning a new small group ministry and the time has arrived.

These SGMs are an occasion for you to join with 6-8 others who take their faith seriously, and desire to study God's Word, pray, minister, and fellowship with one another. There will be multiple groups that will meet at different times, different locations, and with different leaders.
